

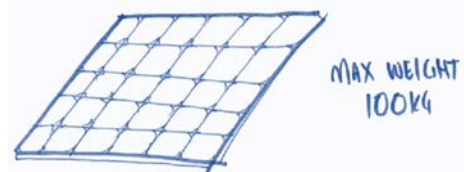
SOLAR PANELS Development Guide

What needs Council approval?

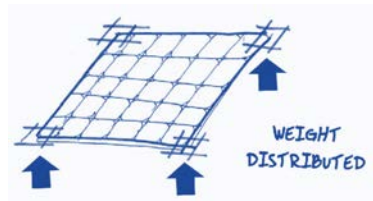
Any solar panels on freestanding frames will require a development application.

To install solar photovoltaic panels on the roof of a building without Council approval, the following requirements will need to be met;

1. The total weight of the solar panel system should not exceed 100kg



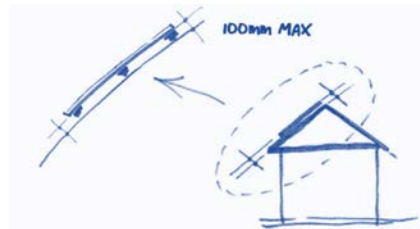
2. Should the weight exceed 100kg, it must be distributed so that no point of attachment has a weight load greater than 100kg



3. No part of the system can overhang the roof of the building



4. The distance between the underside of the panels and the roof not exceeding 100mm



5. The panels will need to be installed by a contractor with the appropriate accreditation

Please note: these exemptions do not apply for a State or Local Heritage Place. Should you wish to install to the roof of either, a development application will be required.



What if I do not fulfil all of these requirements?

If you cannot fulfil all of these requirements, you will be required to lodge a Development Application with Council.
