Council is seeking through Expressions of Interest (EOI) qualified Marina and Boat Precinct operators and occupiers as part of the Jane Eliza Development.

This exciting opportunity continues the Jane Eliza vision of delivering a nationally significant tourism marina asset and supporting infrastructure.

Securing a quality operator and occupier is key to the success of the Marina and Boat Industry Precinct, particularly given the high-profile tourism role of the precinct and growth expectations of this market.

The Jane Eliza Development Project is well progressed and has entered into its second stage to narrow down a development partner. This search for potential operators and occupiers through an EOI is being done in parallel to securing a development partner.

Potential operators and occupiers have the benefit of their requirements for the Marina and Boat Precinct to be considered by the development partner and Council as part of the design development process.

The Marina and Boat Industry Precinct is expected to include a range of facilities that house and support key boating services facilities including:

- Marina
- Commercial operations
 - Boat repair and maintenance services
 - River-based tourism operators
 - Boat, vessel and watercraft sales
 - Commercial offices and facilities for houseboat operators
 - Any complementary boating industry support services / amenity
- Provision of utilities and fuel supplies
- Boat, vessel and watercraft storage
- Hardstand
- Drydock / slipway
