RV Parks Open for Visitors

Renmark Paringa Council is pleased to announce the reopening of SS Ellen RV Park and the partial reopening of Plush's Bend RV Park following temporary closures due to the River Murray Flood.

The popular RV Parks have been closed for camping since late 2022 to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our visitors due to inundation from high river levels. Since drying out, the sites have required an extensive clean up, removal of debris and safety assessments, with staff diligently working through these processes which are now complete.

SS Ellen RV Park has fully reopened with all sites (7) bookable for fully self-contained Caravans and RVs (must have fitted grey water tank) and camper trailers.

Plush's Bend will partially reopen with 11 riverside sites bookable for fully self-contained Caravans and RVs (must have fitted grey water tank) only. Sites 5-8 and 16-30 (Unallocated Section) have some minor inundation and will remain closed until the water subsidies and the area can dry out. The low entry crossing has some water flowing across it (50mm), however this is not impacting access currently.

Mayor, Peter Hunter said 'we are delighted to welcome back RV travellers and visitors to experience our beautiful surrounds once again and to discover all that Renmark and our region has to offer'.
