

## Taylor Riverfront Precinct – Project Commencement

1 June 2020

The Taylor Riverfront Precinct project will commence on **Monday 1 June 2020**, with the principal contractor taking possession of the site at Murray Avenue, Renmark.

A sod turning ceremony by Mr Tony Pasin, MP will be held on Tuesday 2 June at 12:00pm. The project will see the activation of our premier riverfront by the removal of car parks and the development of an outdoor space that will draw people to stay, play and anchor them within our Renmark CBD.

The successful contractor for the project is a specialist in open space development, a key consideration in awarding this contract was the extent of local content, with 6 local contractors to be employed for this exciting development.

Pedestrian movements will be maintained around the construction area with water filled bollards placed along Ral Ral Avenue to ensure the safe movement of pedestrians from Ral Ral Avenue to Murray Avenue on the River side of the road way, as detailed in the image below.

The first few months you will predominantly see demolition and underground works occurring with the exciting features starting to be more noticeable from approximately September/ October 2020. The project is expected to be completed in February 2021.

This project has been driven by the community and we look forward to sharing our progress on the activation of this part of our landscape.
