POLICY

- 1) No petitions, questionnaires, surveys, raffle tickets or the likes for outside persons/organisations, are to be placed in the public areas of the Community and Civic Centre, Public Library and Visitor Information Centre,
- 2) No goods for sale of any description from outside persons/organisations, are to be placed in the public areas of the Community and Civic Centre and Public Library,
- 3) No goods for sale, except those relating to the operation of the Visitor Information Centre are to be placed in the Centre except for those items on consignment
- 4) Council initiated displays be exempt from this provision

DELEGATION

That pursuant to section 44 of the Local Government Act 1999, Council delegates to the Chief Executive Officer authority to administer Council's Policies.
