OBJECTIVE

To provide framework and guidance for businesses and tourist attractions to apply for finger point directional signs within the Renmark Paringa Council area.

POLICY

The erection of finger point signs affixed to a stand-alone steel post, shall be permitted where required to direct tourists to businesses located off major road thoroughfares or operating from the riverfront; provided the following:

1. The location is approved by Manager Infrastructure Services ,
2. There is sufficient space to place sign on existing post taking into consideration,
 - 2.1. no more than 5 signs permitted on each post including any Council signage, or
 - 2.2. distance from ground level to bottom of lowest sign is not less than 1.6 metres
3. Only one post and any regulatory signage post permitted on each corner of intersection or at the pontoon on the riverfront adjacent the Renmark Club.

Businesses where their principal frontage is facing a major road are not eligible for a finger post sign. Major Roads include

- Murray Avenue, Renmark
- Renmark Avenue, Renmark
- Eighteenth Street, Renmark
- Ral Ral Avenue, Renmark
- Sturt Highway (entire length in Renmark Paringa Council boundaries)

All approved signs shall be of standard aluminium blade class 1 reflective construction and supplied and erected by Council at the cost of the applicant.

Council will consider unique signage on an as required basis; however overall dimensions and lettering sizes must remain the same as the standard signage.

The applicant shall be responsible for future maintenance and replacement costs. Approved signs shall be of a colour which complies with the appropriate Australian Standards:

- Blue – services for example toilets, hospitals
- Brown – recognised tourist and historical attractions
- Green – general use for example, businesses

The replacement of existing finger post signs shall be consistent with this Policy.
