Renmark Paringa Council announce the recipients of Community Grants, Community Support Funding and Event Sponsorship for 2023-24

Renmark Paringa Council is pleased to announce the recipients of Community Grants, Community Support Funding and Event Sponsorship for the 2023/24 financial year.

Five applicants were awarded a **Community Grant** to assist with funding a variety of projects that provide a strong community benefit to their organisation as well as the wider Renmark Paringa community.

The successful applicants and projects include:

- Girl Guides South Australia Inc \$4,000
 Renmark Guide Hall Upgrade Re-roof, re-clad wall linings, electrical work, fix windows, replace rainwater tank, demolish chimney and external toilet at the Renmark Girl Guide Hall.
- Renmark Bowling Club \$4,000 Kitchen Upgrade - Installation of new benches and sink at Renmark Bowling Club.
- Renmark Paringa Community Museum \$3,000

 Preservation of exhibits Preserve and conserve exhibits which are displayed at the Renmark Paringa Community Museum repairing, painting and staining.
- Renmark Rovers Football Club \$4,000
 Air-conditioning upgrade Installation of new air-conditioning and heating system at Renmark Rovers Football Club.
- Vitor Renmark Amateur Swimming Club \$1,762

 Purchase of training equipment (including fins, kickboards, pull buoys, Tow Sponges and a viewing screen to review technique).

Six applicants were awarded **Community Support Funding** to support local initiatives conducted by not-for-profit organisations in developing community service projects, social welfare and other community purposes. This funding will be provided to each organisation annually for the duration for the current term of Council (2023/24, 2024/25, 2025/26 and 2026/27).

The successful applicants include:

• Chaffey Theatre – Country Arts SA - \$2,600 Ambassador Program and Nunga Screen.

• Crafty Capers - \$1,000

Purchase of wadding to be used in quilts that are made and donated to hospitals/hospices for patients suffering serious, long term or terminal illnesses.

- Foodbank of South Australia Incorporated \$5,000

 Food relief for those in need in the Renmark Parings community
 - Food relief for those in need in the Renmark Paringa community.
- Riverland Christmas Appeal \$2,000

Hampers of food and toys for members of the Renmark Paringa community at Christmas time.

• Riverland Youth Theatre - \$5,000

Annual program of activities, events, and opportunities in matters of arts, wellbeing, and joy for young people (18-30) and older (30+) that are free to participants to be a part of.

• Rotary Club of Berri - \$250

Riverland & Mallee Vocational Awards.

Four applicants were awarded **Event Sponsorship** to assist in the delivery of financially sustainable events which result in positive economic, experimental, and social outcomes from the Renmark Paringa community.
