Renmark's Christmas on the Murray Festival 2022 – Scaled back due to the rising River Murray levels



Renmark Paringa Council has made the decision to scale back Renmark's Christmas on the Murray Festival 2022 so that resources can be directed into Council's flood response.

Most Council-led Christmas events need to be either scaled back or cancelled in order to prioritise staff resources on flood preparations. In addition, the peak flow is expected to occur as the same time as the Christmas on the Murray Festival and Council's focus will need to be firmly on the protection of the community. As such, the Festive Friday Street Party, Twilight Christmas Gift Markets, Perform in the Precinct, Games On & Festive Flix and the Teddy Bear's Picnic events will not proceed.

However, performances by the Adelaide Big Band at the Chaffey Theatre, Christmas Fun at the Library incorporating a musical show by Cool 4 Kids, Santa's Cave and Face Painting plus the ever popular School Holiday Program <u>will proceed</u> at this point in time as part of the revised program. Council will also continue to promote the community led events including Carols in the Garden and the Family Fun Day at the Renmark Swimming Centre.

"The timing of the Council facilitated festive events, together with the unprecedented demands placed on Council's resources with the ongoing rising river levels and forecasted River Murray flood peak means that we are unable to commit to delivering the whole program of planned events for 2022" said a Council spokesperson.

Council aims to ensure that a festive feel is created across our towns with the lighting of the Renmark Christmas Tree and giant festive star decoration together with installing the solar and Christmas banners in towns.

"Although the Festival program will not run as originally planned, we are pleased that some events will continue and that Christmas will still shine bright throughout the town. While it is unfortunate that these changes are necessary, Council's highest priority is and must be the protection of our community".

Council will commence promotion of the 2022 Renmark's Christmas on the Murray Festival on its website in the coming weeks. Details on the events and how to purchase tickets will be promoted there.
