## **Paringa Town Centre set for Revitalisation**

The Paringa Town Centre is set to undergo a transformative revitalisation with exciting improvements planned to enhance the centre for residents and visitors alike.

Council conducted community consultation in 2022 for the 'Paringa Place Plan' with the aim to beautify and upgrade the town centre. The community were given the opportunity to provide feedback with a number of projects identified, including upgraded public toilets, a nature play space and additional signage.

The community can expect a further opportunity for consultation on the nature play space, which will take place early in the new year. The consultation will give the community an opportunity to provide feedback on the type of play equipment they would like to see in the nature play space.

A critical milestone in this project is the recent appointment of LCS Landscapes as the lead contractor. LCS Landscapes have previously undertaken work with Council having constructed the award-winning Taylor Riverland Precinct. LCS Landscapes have also been appointed the lead contractor for the 180 Murray Avenue Open Space Development which will provide efficiencies and cost savings for Council.

Moreover, it is also with great excitement that we announce the securing of an additional \$177,367 in funding towards the Paringa Town Centre Revitalisation through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program. This extra funding will ensure Council can deliver a greater number of projects and priorities identified by the community to create a vibrant and thriving town centre.

Mayor Peter Hunter said:

'The revitalisation of the Paringa Town Centre represents an opportunity to invigorate the heart of the Paringa community, creating a space that promotes wellbeing, social connection and local pride.'
