Disability access and inclusion plans 1.1 The power pursuant to and in accordance with Section 16(3) of the Disability Inclusion Act 2018 ("the Act") to determine the content to be included in the Council's disability access and inclusion plan. 1.2 The power pursuant to Section 16(5) of the Act to make application to the Minister for approval to prepare a single disability access and inclusion plan for more than one council. 1.3 The power pursuant to Section 16(6) of the Act to vary a disability access and inclusion plan in accordance with the requirements prescribed by regulation. 1.4 The power pursuant to Section 16(7) of the Act to determine the format and website for publication of the disability access and inclusion plan, ensuring that the format is accessible to people with a disability. s27	2. Sharing of information between certain persons and bodies 2.1 The power pursuant to Section 27(2) of the Act to provide prescribed information and documents (as defined by Section 27(&) of the Act) to another person or body to whom Section 27 applies, regardless of whether or not the Council has been requested to provide the information, if the delegate reasonably believes that the provision of the information or documents would assist the recipient: 2.1.1 to perform functions relating to people with disability; or 2.1.2 to manage any risk to a person with disability, or class of people with disability, that might arise in the recipient's capacity as an employer or provider of services. 2.2 The power pursuant to Section 27(5) of the Act to request, on behalf of the Council, prescribed information and documents from a person to whom Section 27 applies.
