Located amongst the school precinct of Renmark, the Chaffey Community Centre, has a history of local community engagement and offers opportunities which promote connection, interaction, learning and community participation.

It serves as a home base for locals and community groups to meet, enables activities, classes for alternative learning options and events, reflecting local interests and needs, and offers a range of services and quality programs.

The Centre aims to be culturally inclusive and accommodates a range of interests across a diverse palate of computing, literacy, gardening, cooking, sewing, craft and community engagement.

The Centre offers

- An open space area —tables and chairs for up to 40 people

- Fully equipped kitchen facilities

- Computer Alcove

- Fax and photocopier service—fee applies

The Centre provides office space and meeting rooms for hire to a variety of service providers on a casual and permanent basis at affordable rates.

Access to tables, chairs and kitchen facilities and the availability to cater for a diverse range of functions.

Prices vary depending on the room, type of activity and group.

Currently the centre is used by government agencies, financial services, counselling services, education providers, professional and private business, community groups (volunteer organisations and non profit organisations), commercial organisations, private individual meetings, conferences and seminars.

The Chaffey Community Centre is accessible to all in our community and exists to promote the wellbeing of the whole community by providing a range of services and activities which are developed in response to community needs.
